What data is collected?

Information is also held about students' musical education including lesson plans, exam results and reports.

How is the data collected?

Contact data is collected through the website contact form, initial phone call or email. Additional data explained above is collected during the consultation meeting and in subsequent lessons as necessary.

How is the data stored?

Data is stored in the following ways:

- If you contact me via the website form, data is stored securely in the Wix CRM (Customer Relationship Management) contact system and in Microsoft Outlook.
- If you email or telephone me directly, contact details are stored in my Microsoft Outlook system.
- All data is also stored in paper format.

All reasonable steps are taken to keep your data secure.

How is the data used?

The information is used:

- to communicate with students/parents/guardians regarding the piano tuition provided.
- to support the teaching process.

Data is not used for marketing purposes.

Is the data shared?

Some information is required by Exam Boards for exam entry. This will be clear on the entry form. No other third parties will have access to your personal data unless there is a legal obligation for it to be provided.

How long is the data kept?

Data is generally kept for a minimum of 7 years.
